17-18 School Supply List
Elementary (PK-6)

Prek – Mrs. Cornell - 1 two pocket folder, cube box of tissues, container of Clorox/Lysol or baby wipes, Crib sized blanket, change of clothes, backpack (NO WHEELS) big enough to hold a large library book), paint smock, sweater or sweatshirt to leave in school. Everything should be labeled w/the child's name. We have breakfast, lunch & snack each day. We celebrate birthdays – you may send in a treat.

KINDERGARTEN — box of 24 crayons, 1 pkg. glue sticks, 2 containers of Clorox/Lysol wipes, package of napkins, crib size blanket & paint smock labeled w/name, backpack – NO WHEELS – big enough to hold a large library book, package of markers, complete set of clothes labeled in a zip lock bag, box of tissues, package of colored pencils. Donated items would be appreciated: large paper plates, small paper plates, white lunch bags, zip lock bags (any size), cotton balls.

1st GRADE – 2 boxes crayons, 10-12 pencils, 3 pkgs. Glue sticks, folders- 1 two pocket (red & blue), 2 container of sanitizing wipes, more in January. Crayons (child's choice), 10-12 pencils (provide a package that will be distributed to your child throughout the year), 3 pkgs. glue sticks, erasers (1 pkg.), folders – 2 two pocket folders of your child's choice, 2 containers of sanitizing wipes, more in January, pencil box.

2nd GRADE – 2 pkgs. of #2 pencils (Ticonderoga wooden are the best), crayons (box of 24), 2 laminated folders w/pockets, pencil box, pencil cap erasers & 2 pink square erasers, 2 glue sticks, 1 box of 12 colored pencils, 2 boxes of tissues, 2 canisters of disinfecting Clorox wipes or Lysol wipes.

3rd GRADE – 2 – two pocket folders of your choice (1 for Friday folder & 1 for homework folder) – may be creative & different, 2 pkgs. wide ruled Loose leaf paper, 1 bound composition notebook (writing journal), box of crayons, 1 pkg. glue sticks, 2 doz. #2 Ticonderoga pencils, pencil top erasers, 1 pkg. zippered pencil pouch. Everyone – box of tissues.

4th GRADE – 2 -marble composition books, 2 -one-subject spiral notebook, 1 pkg. of lined loose leaf paper, 1 pack #2 Ticonderoga pencils, colored pencils (no mechanical pencils, please), Clorox or Lysol wipes (2 pkgs.), flash cards –multiplication, division, pencil pouch case w/zipper, 1 pkg. loose leaf wide ruled paper, 2 – folders w/pockets (take home folder), 1 pkg. colored pencils or crayons.

5th GRADE –Math & Science – 1 Inch 3 ring clip binder, 4 tab dividers, 1 folder.

ELA & SS - 2 notebooks, 1 – 1 in. binder, 4 tab dividers, 1 folder.

Reading – folder and 1 subject notebook.

General - a sturdy folder to use as a homework folder, lots of #2 pencils, 2 pkg. of paper, colored pencils, a highlighter

Health 5 – writing utensils, notebook, loose leaf paper, note cards, colored pencils, assignment pad.

6th GRADE - ELA & SS- 5 notebooks, 5 – 2 pocket folders (each a different color), 1 pkg. colored pencils, Lots of #2 pencils, pencil cap erasers, pencil sharpener w/shaving collection, 2 pkgs. loose leaf paper, 3 non-sticking book covers, highlighters, 1 flash drive, pocket folder for Spanish.

Math – RED – 2” binder, loose leaf paper, 5 dividers, pencils L& pens.

Science – loose leaf paper, notebook, folders, pens, pencils, colored pencils.

Spanish – lots of pens/pencils & a sturdy pocket folder.

Mrs. Spado – 2 pkgs. #2 pencils, 5 notebooks, pencil top erasers, 3 folders, 1 pkg. dry erase markers, 1 pkg. highlighters, 1 pkg. markers or crayons, 1 pencil box, 2 boxes of tissues, 4 glue sticks, 1 pkg. Clorox wipes, hand sanitizer, Grades 5 & 6 – 1 USB Flash drive.

K-6 PHYSICAL EDUCATION: SNEAKERS & APPROPRIATE ATTIRE: Sneakers that tie, Velcro, or slip on that are appropriate size are recommended.

Skateboarding style sneakers are not recommended, because they do not tie and have tendency to come flying off the feet. Also, heel less sneakers are not recommended as they can come off at anytime. Try to dress casually on PE days (dresses and skirts can cause embarrassment) and belts are recommended to cover appropriate body parts. Also, shoes (slip on or dress), sandals, crocs, flip flops, & hiking boots are not recommended. Sneakers & socks should be worn or brought to school on PE days.
