

Smart Results at Edmeston Central School

Smart Results is a teacher driven school-wide initiative at Edmeston Central School to improve our students' academic performance. Smart Results is a systematic approach to improving teaching and learning that incorporates these elements:

- Instruction in all courses is individualized to meet student needs.
- Individual student performance data is used to track student progress.
- Teachers create individualized plans (called prototypes) to improve student learning
- TDA (Target, Data, Action) – set the target for learning in concrete measurable terms, track student performance data, and determine the action taken to help students meet the target. Review the results of the action by examining the data. Repeat this cycle continuously.

Here are the Smart Results Goals for Edmeston Central School for the 2011-12 school year:

1. All K-12 students at or above grade level in literacy
2011-12 success point – 70% at or above grade level
2. Increase proficiency on 3-8 assessments to 85%/40% and on Regents Exams to 90%/20%
2011-12 success point – 70%/20% on 3-8 assessments
90%/40% on Regents Exams
3. Reduce course failures in grades 5-12 by 70%
2011-12 success point – 25%
4. Increase the graduation rate to 95%
2011-12 success point – all current seniors will graduate in June
